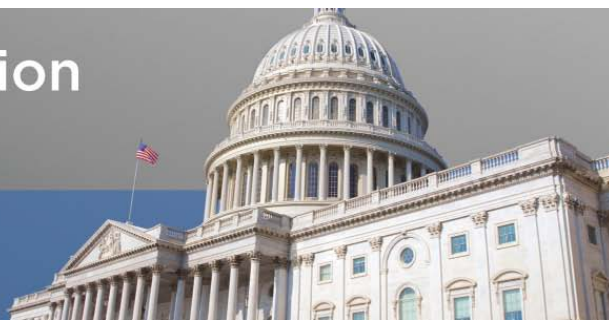


10-Year Anniversary Delegation

March 21-22, 2012 | Washington, D.C.



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Leadership Health Care (LHC) 10-Year Anniversary Delegation to Washington, D.C. will offer delegates the unique opportunity to hear from members of Congress, Administration officials, Capitol Hill staff and national health care thought leaders on health care policies, the status of the federal health care budget, perspectives on reform implementations and views on the impact of both the Supreme Court's reform hearing and the November elections.

LHC's 10th visit to the nation's capital will further acquaint industry leaders with current and breaking health care issues as well share perspectives on as the policy environment. The delegation will also showcase Nashville's robust, entrepreneurial and diverse \$70 billion health care industry to the Washington health care policy community.

Delegates will include approximately 100 individuals in leadership growth positions representing the diverse sectors of the health care industry, such as hospital management, outpatient care, disease management and health information technology. Additionally, delegates will represent professional service firms supporting the industry including finance, legal, public affairs and others.

PROGRAM AGENDA

The delegation will begin at **1.45 p.m. (EST)** on **Wednesday, March 21** and end at **1.00 p.m. (EST)** on **Thursday, March 22**.

Programming on Wednesday, March 21 will take place at **The Madison**, located at **1177 15th Street, NW, Washington, DC 20005**. Programming on Thursday, March 22 will take place at the **U.S. Capitol Visitor Center**, Capitol Hill. Group transportation will be provided to and from The Madison and Capitol Hill. At the conclusion of the program, delegates will arrive back at The Madison for luggage pick up **before 1.45 p.m.** Luggage cannot be stored on Capitol Hill or on the bus.

The delegation will include two-half days of programming, including briefings and panel discussions as well as a special welcome reception and dinner featuring keynote speaker **Robert Gibbs, Former White House Press Secretary and Outside Advisor to President Barack Obama**. These invitation-only evening events will take place at The Madison.

Delegation programming will explore industry issues that will include reimbursement and funding as well as the status on implementing key components of the 2010 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. The agenda will feature distinguished decision-makers, thought-leaders and health care industry stakeholders, including Congressional members,
